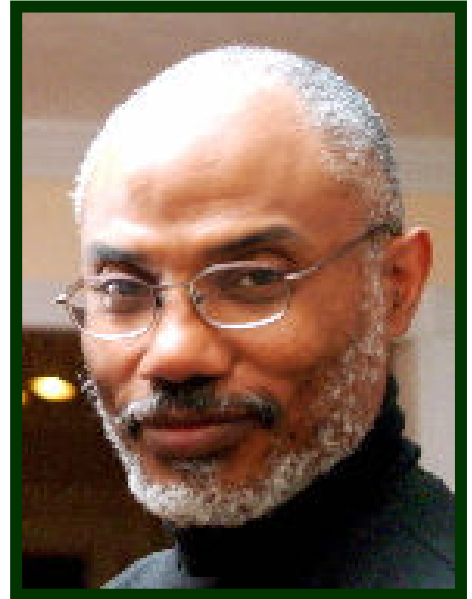


Wekesa O. Madzimoyo
